1. Purpose

The present organisational guidelines shall govern the organisation of the admission procedure for studies commencing in the Summer Semester 2024/2025 and the Winter Semester 2025/2026.

The result of the admission examination verifying the level of knowledge and competencies for study in a given study programme shall be a "Passed" or "Failed" grade.

The admission examination shall also include verification of the language proficiency for the study unless the applicant proves them by an internationally recognised certificate according to the SERR or proof of passing a language examination issued by another institution authorised to conduct language examinations.

A B2 level of English is required for admission to the programme.

Language proficiency shall be assessed by means of an in-house Comprehensive Language Assessment testing that encompasses all language skills: reading, listening, writing and speaking in English.

The test includes:

- a) An on-line test focusing on the use of language in practice and listening,
- b) A 60-minute on-line session with an examiner to test reading, speaking and writing skills.

The result of the admission test verifying language aptitude for study shall be a "Passed" or "Failed" grade.

Both parts of the entrance examination shall be the subject of a protocol.

5. Applicants with special educational needs
